Our students performance in AISSE Examinations has always been exemplary. It is proud to state that this glorious account continues with our students achieving unparalleled success consistently for the 24<sup>th</sup> year in the All India Secondary School Examination conducted by CBSE in March 2020.

This year, **186 students** appeared for this Examination. The **School Topper** – **Ahana Chatterjee** proudly scored **96.6%** in aggregate. She was closely followed by **Khushi Pareek** with **96.4%** at the **Second Position** and the **Third Position** was shared by three students – **Ayush Mohanty, Aayushi Pradhan, and Harsh Dadwal** by securing **95%** in aggregate.

The diligence and sincere efforts of our students have helped them in making a remarkable feat by scoring highest marks of **100/100** marks in **Maths** , **99** out of **100** marks in **English & Social Science** and **98** out of **100** marks in **Hindi & Science**.

## **INFRASTRUCTURE**

Computer lab enhances scientific and technological research and invention capacity of students. The lab is equipped with 26 LCD Computers that cater to the needs of the students.

The audio-visual room provides a realistic approach and enhances deep understanding in the students of Pre- Primary Section. A large collection of CDs and DVDs enthrals the curious mind of the tiny tots.

### **E BOARDS IN CLASSROOMS**
