During the last two challenging years, the school had managed to maintain teaching standards with the help of all our stakeholders. I salute the priceless efforts and incredible work of all the students, teachers and parents who experienced the unprecedented change, underwent a series of adjustments from physical classroom to online platform, amid new technological demands.

Lok Puram Public School has a rich legacy of providing academic excellence blended with co-curricular activities since **1993.**This journey of **29 years** has so far been very satisfying. The school empowers children to collaborate, think independently and develop problem solving skills at their own pace. It is also our constant endeavour to equip these learners with values and sensitize them towards community services.

With greatest pleasure, I bring forth, the **Annual Report** for the academic session 2022-23.

At present, **2050** (approx.) students are being mentored under a team of **94** qualified Educators.

CBSE BOARD RESULTS

I feel extremely honoured to announce the historic performance of our students in the All India Secondary School Examination of Std X conducted by CBSE in April 2022. It is indeed the proudest moment for us all as we have maintained the mark of Cent Percent Result Record, consistently for the 26th year.

A total of 208 students had appeared for this examination, out of which, 188 students secured First Class, among these 128 students secured Distinction marks i.e. 75% and above. Remaining 20 students secured Second Class. In all, 56 students scored 90% and above in the aggregate out of which 21 students secured 95% and above marks in aggregate.

The **School Topper - Nihira Patwardhan** has broken all the previous records by scoring a huge **99.80%** in the aggregate and registered her glorious victory in the Pages of Lok Puram Public School. She scored **499 marks** out of **500 marks**. **She has topped in the city limits of Thane**.

The Second School Topper- **Sanyam Patil** too secured **a big 99**%in the aggregate and in the Third Place, **Atharv Pathak**, scored **98.6%in** aggregate.

Beside this, our students have added to the glory of the school by achieving **100/100 marks** in all subjects:

8 students scored 100/100 in English, 2 students in Hindi, 2 students in Mathematics, 3 students in Science and 3 students secured 100/100 in Social Science subjects.

I must mention here that these children have hardly attended physical schooling, yet managed to raise the flagship of Lok Puram Public School with their grit and determination.

The exceptional performance manifested by our students is the outcome of great support of school management, dedicated teachers and our active parents. This triangular bond has helped our students to reach the mark of victory even during the difficult situation.

INFRASTRUCTURE

School infrastructure and facilities foster high quality learning outcomes. It creates interest in students in the process of teaching-learning.

LIBRARY

The school library plays a pivotal role in the lives of students by serving as the store house of knowledge. The school library has a wide range of approx. **17,901** Books, Periodicals, Magazines, Films, Newspapers, Maps, CDs, Cassettes, DVDs etc. catering to all levels of students.

MATHS LAB

The Mathematics laboratory inspires, stimulates and equips students to challenge and solve the theories by testing their ideas through various activities and teaching aids.

SCIENCE LABORATORY

A scientific temperament is nurtured through fully equipped and suitable designed integrated science lab which helps the inquisitive minds.

COMPUTER LABORATORY

ICT Laboratory enables learners to acquire digital skills in the modern world. The School Computer Laboratory is equipped with **26 LCD** Computers with software application, data handling and other learning activities.

AUDIO-VISUAL ROOM

Audio-Visual Room aids in making the teaching learning process more enjoyable for our tiny tots. The school has a varied collection of CDs and DVDs to stimulate the interest of these toddlers.

E-BOARD IN CLASSROOMS

Interactive Smart Boards are used in all classrooms to provide students with an enriched learning experience which facilitates additional teaching aids.

MOBILE APP

Important messages, circulars, notices etc. are conveyed to parents through **ESS**Messaging School Mobile App which is registered with the mobile phones of all parents.

FEE PAYMENT APP

My Class Board Fee Payment App had been installed for the benefit of all parents in order to pay the school fees through multiple payment gateways on online mode.

SECURITY MEASURES

The school is under CCTV surveillance, Fire Alarm system & Fire Extinguishers are installed at strategic points. Main gates of the school are constantly guarded by both male & female security personnel.

The school conducts Regular Remedial Classes in Mathematics for Std IX and X to provide special guidance to students who need extra attention.

SCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATOR

We have a Special Educator who conducts remedial sessions for Certified Learning Disabled students to improve their academic performance and ensure that individual needs of each child is fulfilled in academics.

COUNSELLING

We have an In-House School Counsellor to help students with behavioural & emotional needs. This year the Counsellor focused on helping students accept a new normal routine and restore emotional health on topics such as: on Post Covid Management, Importance of Relaxation, Practicing Mindfulness, Managing Time, harmful effects of Bullying, Dealing with Anxiety, Developing Patience etc.

SCHOOL CLUBS CONSERVATION CLUB

In order preserve the natural environment, activities on following topics were conducted: Card Making by reusing old newspapers, How to Keep Water Clean and Safe During Monsoons, Conserving Endangered and Extinct Aquatic Species, Making of Manure in School Compost Tumbler, Accordion on Methods of Irrigation, Water Audit, Rain Water Harvesting etc.
