ACADEMICS

- The Academic Session **2026–27** commenced on **Wednesday, 1st April 2026**.
- An **Orientation Programme on the Assessment Pattern** for the parents of **Std. I to V** was held on **25th April 2026** to update them about the curriculum and assessment system.
- The school reopened after the **Summer Vacation** on **Wednesday, 10th June 2026**.
- **Class Tests** for **Std I to V** were conducted from **15th June to 19th June 2026**.
- The **Investiture Ceremony** was held on **24th June 2026**. The Sports Captain and all the Office Bearers took the oath of office and were presented with badges.
- **Cycle-1 (Std. I & II)** and **Formative Assessment-1 (Std. III, IV & V)** are tentatively scheduled from **14th July to 18th July 2026**.
- Subject worksheets for **Std. I to V** are being given regularly. Revision worksheets will be provided shortly for additional practice.
- The timetable and syllabus/portion for **Cycle-1 and FA-1** was shared with all students of **Std. I to V**.
- **Cycle-2 (Std. I & II)** and **FA-2 (Std. III, IV & V)** will be conducted in **August 2026**.
- **Cycle-3 (Std. I & II)** and **SA-1 (Std. III, IV & V)** will be conducted in **September 2026**.
- **The Open Day for Cycle-1 and FA-1 for Std. I to V will be held on Saturday, 25th July 2026.**

HAPPENINGS

- An **Evacuation Drill** for Std. I to V was conducted on 8th April 2026, with a successful evacuation time of 4 minutes.
- **Maharashtra Day** was celebrated on 1st May 2026 by hoisting the National Flag, followed by singing the National Song and the State Song.
- An **Eye Check-up Camp** for Std. I to V was conducted on 17th and 18th June 2026.
- The **12th International Yoga Day** was celebrated on 20th June 2026 with great enthusiasm. Students delivered speeches in English and Hindi on the importance of yoga, followed by Sanskrit shlokas, warm-up exercises, Surya Namaskars, and various yoga asanas, promoting physical and mental well-being and encouraging healthy living habits.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Conservation Club

Earth Day was celebrated on 22nd April 2026 in collaboration with the Conservation Club through various grade-wise activities to promote environmental awareness.

- **Std I – My Fingerprint Earth:** Students created the Earth using blue and green fingerprint dots. A worksheet was provided.
- **Std II – Small Hands, Big Change:** Students coloured and decorated a happy Earth using blue and green crayons. A worksheet was provided.
- **Std III – Be Eco-Friendly:** Students made a handprint on an A4-sized sheet and wrote the pledge, “I will carry a cloth bag.”
- **Std IV – Save Every Drop:** Students wrote a 4–5 line jingle on water conservation on an A4-sized sheet.
- **Std V – Be the Solution:** Students made paper bags using old newspapers.

Environment Day - As per **CBSE and State Directives**, various activities were conducted to raise environmental awareness and encourage students to adopt sustainable practices in the month of June.

- **Std I – Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam 3.0 (Tree Plantation Drive):** Students planted a sapling with their mother and shared a photograph along with a placard containing the required details.
- **Std II – Waste Segregation Game:** Students brought one item each of dry waste and kitchen waste to understand the importance of waste segregation.
- **Std III – Green Promise Leaf Tree:** Students created a paper leaf with an eco-friendly promise to contribute towards a greener future.
- **Std IV – Plant a Herb Activity:** Students planted a herb in a recycled container and observed its growth by recording the planting date, plant height and number of leaves.
- **Std V – Be an Energy Saver:** Students observed and recorded energy-saving practices at home or school, created an “Energy Saver” badge and completed an observation sheet.
