ACADEMICS

- **New Academic Session 2026-2027** began from **1st April 2026**.
- An **Orientation Programme** was conducted on **25th April 2026** for Parents of Std. VI to X to update them with curriculum for the New Academic Session 2026-27.
- **School reopened** after Summer Vacations on **10th June 2026**.
- **Second Board Examination** was conducted from **15th May to 22nd May 2026**. Around 32 students appeared for the same.
- **Class Test I** was conducted from **15th June to 20th June 2026** & the Answer papers were shared with parents on **27th June 2026**.
- **Practice & Revision worksheets** for all subjects are being given as per schedule.
- **Remedial classes in Mathematics and Science** will commence from **1st July 2026** for those students of Std IX and X who require extra focus and attention.
- **Group and Individual Counselling Sessions** are being taken by the School Counsellor regularly for socio-emotional development and other skill development of our children.

HAPPENINGS

- Students celebrated the **Important Days & Festivals** like Good Friday, Ambedkar Jayanti, Ram Navami etc through awareness programmes in the morning assembly.
- **An HPV Vaccination Awareness Session** took place on **4th April 2026**, to educate parents of Std IX and X girls on vital health prevention. Resource Persons, Mr. Santosh Latpate and Mrs. Sunita Murmure from Gandhinagar Health Centre, TMC Hospital, highlighted the safety and benefits of the vaccine in preventing cervical cancer in girls.
- **A Fire Safety Workshop** was organized for students of Std VII & VIII on **7th April, 2026**. Fire Officers Mr. Nilesh Vetal and Mr. Omkar Vaiety from the Balkum Fire Station, Thane, sensitized students how to safely handle fire emergencies. The session concluded with a live demonstration on how to extinguish a fire.
- **Mock Evacuation Drill** procedures were successfully carried out in the school on **8th April 2026**, to prepare students & staff for unexpected emergencies. Guided by a floor-wise evacuation plan, the entire building was safely cleared in approximately four minutes.
- **A Cyber Security Workshop** was conducted for Std IX students on **9th April 2026**. Guest speakers Mr. Anil Shirode (Assistant Police Inspector) and Mr. Vishwanath Biwalkar (Chairman of Eagle Brigade Foundation, Thane) educated the students about various online threats & emphasized the importance of protecting personal data while using social networking sites.

- **An Electricity Safety Workshop** was held on **16th June 2026** for the students of Std VI & VII. The Resource Person Mr. Vipul Bhingardive, Junior Engineer, (Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Limited) explained electrical dangers and shared vital safety rules to follow.
- **A Financial Literacy** session was conducted for the students of Std X on **18th April 2026**. Expert speaker, Mr. Bharat Banzal(Vice President) and Mrs. Asmita Desai (Associate Vice President) from Unit Trust of India highlighted the importance and techniques of saving and investment.
- **Earth Day on 22nd April 2026** was marked with various hands-on activities integrated with the Conservation Club. Also, students delivered speeches & rendered melodious songs on the need of a greener environment.
- **Scholastic Book Exhibition** was organised in the school on **25th April 2026** to promote reading skills amongst children. A plethora of books for all age groups were displayed.

CLUB ACTIVITIES

The following Club activities were conducted for the month of April and June for the students of Std VI to X:

Conservation Club

Earth Day was celebrated through the following activities emphasizing on the Mission Statement of the school 'Reduce, Recycle, Reuse and Replenish':

- **Std VI** – Slogan Writing and creative illustrations on the topic 'Save Earth'.

Health Club & Wellness Club

The Club conducted following activities on the theme 'Foundations of Healthy Living: Hygiene & Health':

- **Std VI** – Chart Making on Hand washing demonstration providing a step-by-step visual guide.
- **Std VII** – Chart Making on daily personal hygiene practices.
- **Std VIII** – Pictorial representation of dental hygiene practices, including drawing the anatomical parts of a tooth and proper ways of brushing.
